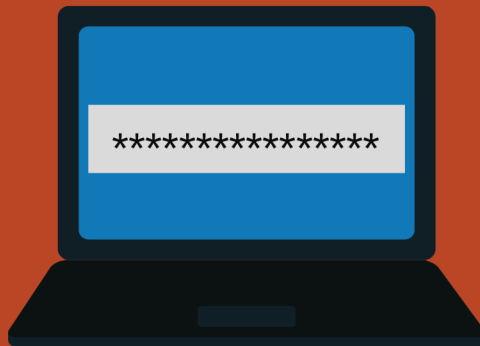

Create strong passwords that can't be easily cracked.

- Use a password of at least 16 characters where possible.
- Make passwords easier to remember for yourself by using a string of words, commonly referred to as a passphrase.
- Consider using a password manager to help you remember your passwords.
- Use more complex passwords on your most sensitive accounts such as your bank account and social media accounts. And if it is available, use multi-factor authentication like a fingerprint or a pin code texted to you.
